In April 2022, Thailand is bringing back our traditional Songkran Festival celebration after the long pause for two years. Songkran is considered as one of the most important holidays in Thailand, which will be celebrated during 13-15 April. The Thai Ministry of Public Health advises people to remain vigilant and practice preventive measures for health and safety during the celebration of Songkran this year. The reintroduction of this festival is part of the road map to label COVID-19 an endemic disease in Thailand by mid-2022.

Soon to come in April is the lifting of the RT-PCR testing requirement within 72 hours before boarding in Thailand's entry measure. An update of this measure will be officially announced once it has been announced in the Royal Thai Government Gazette. The progress for Thailand to fully reopen is moving forward consciously to sustain the safety of both the locals and visitors.

## **Updated Entry Rules for International Arrivals from 1 April 2022**



Thailand's Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) has approved the lifting of the pretravel testing requirement for international arrivals beginning 1 April, 2022, as the kingdom prepares a 4-phase plan to downgrade the COVID-19 pandemic to an endemic disease.

# Key updated entry rules effective from 1 April, 2022, are as follows:

- International arrivals under any of the current three entry schemes – TEST & GO, Sandbox, and Alternative Quarantine (AQ) – will be allowed to enter Thailand without the need to show proof of a negative RT-PCR test within 72 hours of travel.

- Two tests remain in place for the TEST & GO and Sandbox

domestically within Thailand.

travellers: RT-PCR test upon arrival (Day 0) and an antigen self-test on Day 5.

- For Sandbox travellers, the staying period within the Sandbox area will be reduced to 5 days from the current 7 days. After completing 5 days within the Sandbox destinations, travellers will be allowed to travel

- For non-vaccinated travellers entering Thailand with the AQ programme, the quarantine period will be reduced to 5 days, and an RT-PCR test will be required on Day 4-5.

## Bangkok Retains 'Best City' Title in DestinAsian Magazine's 2022 Readers' Choice Awards
